Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

- **IP rights:** Rights granted to creators and owners of works that are the result of human intellectual creativity.
- They include:
 - Trade marks which distinguish goods and services.
 - Patents for new inventions.
 - Registered designs for the design of products.
 - **Copyright** for creative works such as books, paintings and music.


